A WORD FROM IRFON - STRENGTHEN THE HOUSE

When Jesus and His disciples shared the last supper together, the disciples were not aware of the events that were going to unfold. Jesus was!



Jesus comforts them with the words in John 14 v1 "Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid." Jesus is saying the same to us today! We do not understand why things are unfolding as they are, but Jesus does! He is asking us to trust and rely on Him. Just

think of the amazing things that happened following His death and resurrection. We must not doubt what our Lord is preparing for us to be a part of in the future. Jesus did not leave them to go out alone; He loved them far too deeply for that. Yes, they did forsake Him for a while, but Jesus did not forsake them.

What was true that night is just as true today! Our faith is rooted in the conviction that Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever. No matter where we are or what situation we find ourselves in, we are able to rely on Jesus who made His disciples and us a promise that night. John 14 v26 "The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you."



Jesus does not allow us to be alone. He promises to never leave us or forsake us. No matter where we are, or what situation we are in, when we trust in Jesus we are never alone. He will make His will, purposes and plans known to us. All we need to do is ask Him; the Holy Spirit will respond!
