Pastor's Desk: Your Response to King Jesus!

People with integrity do what they say they are going to do. Others just have excuses.



Jesus says: *"Let your Yes be Yes and your No No"*.

In other words, say what you mean and mean what you say.

Matthew 21 is a new section concerning the rejection of Jesus.

Yet this rejection is not always easily seen.

On the first Palm Sunday, People say Yes to Jesus – *"Hosanna in the highest"* but a little while later many are shouting No, *"Crucify Him"*.

People are in the Temple - Yes! A good thing if they are praying and praising God, but by their actions they were being a stumbling block to others.

Jesus in two parables shows that despite Israel saying Yes to God they meant No.

They wanted His salvation, but not to come under His Lordship. They wanted the privilege of being the People of God but not the responsibility to be the Salt and Light of the world.

This Chapter has an underlying theme of Israel's integrity, and so it is a reminder for us to mean what we say as we pray and live our lives for Jesus.

This week Mongolia has gone into total and severe lockdown due to Covid 19. This is Mongolia's first community transfer of the disease. No one is going anywhere except for essential supplies. All flights into and out of the country are cancelled.

Murray and Elizabeth came into UB on Monday 9th November and are stuck in UB, which is a "Ghost Town". The Rio Tinto charter, to Perth, they thought may have been a possibility to get home on 17th November was cancelled. They are hoping that it may be rescheduled to December, and with a new month they may be included in the quarantine quota.

Fairfield is not allowed to operate at all. Only the watchman is allowed on site to keep the heating fires burning. They have applied for permission to do "Home Delivery" but permission not yet granted. It may never come!

Jack returns to Australia this week from New Zealand. Jack and Jaz's wedding has been postponed from 21st January to 18th February in the hope that Murray and Elizabeth can be home by then.

Please pray they will.
