

Pastor's Desk: Ezekiel the Watchman

Today marks Anzac Day. A day where we as Australians pay special tribute to the men and women of the past and present that have served in the armed forces. People that have sacrificed their lives for our freedom. During WW2, my Grandfather, Harold Lane, served as an Aircraft Spotter. And of course, it is safe to assume that his role would be to alert others of any incoming danger.

In today's passage, Ezekiel is told by God to be a watchman. To be a watchman in ancient times is similar to my grandfather's role. A watchman was to be on the lookout from the city gates for any impending danger, and to alert others.

Ezekiel had the tough job of telling the people in Exile that God's judgement is coming, and they need to be ready. To come back to God, repent, believe and follow. Ezekiel was going to be speaking to some difficult people that would be ignorant and stubborn. He must make sacrifices to preach God's word to them. To preach to them, even if it hurts.

We are called to today, to be watchmen. To ready people for God. And it means sacrifice. Sacrificing our reputation, our time, our dreams, our work, our goals in life. Jesus made sacrifices for the greater good. The Anzacs, and all those in the armed forces made sacrifices for the greater good. We need to make sacrifices too, and they won't be wasted, or forgotten.


